We use **Seesaw** to share photographs of the children completing classroom activities and to share information/letters with you.

Please ensure that you can access Seesaw, as most school communications are shared via Seesaw. If you require a code, please speak to a member of staff in the classroom.

Classroom Entrance

To help the children settle in quickly and maintain the right number of staff in the classroom at the start of the day, we kindly ask that you use the **rear entrance via the staff car park** when dropping off children.

This shorter route ensures a smoother, safer transition each morning. Please note that unless your child arrives late or is leaving early, **they cannot be collected from the main reception**. We appreciate your cooperation in keeping drop-off times calm, safe, and efficient
