Topic Title	AoLE drive	Content

One World, Many Stories	Humanities & Health and Wellbeing	We will be studying Black History Month as part of this topic, its significance in society today, and we will be focussing on Martin Luther King as part of our topic work.
Heroes of the Past	Humanities	Our main focus for this topic will be based around Remembrance Day and the sacrifice that has been made during the past for us to live freely today. We will also be looking at Welsh influential figures of the past.
From Imagination to Creation	Science and Technology	This practical topic will be putting our creative minds to work and designing and creating our own products. We will be planning, designing, creating and reviewing our products as part of this topic.

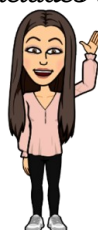
Daily Mile
