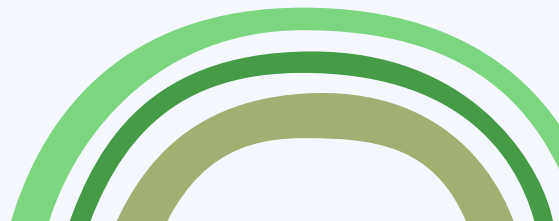
Classroom & Home Reminders:

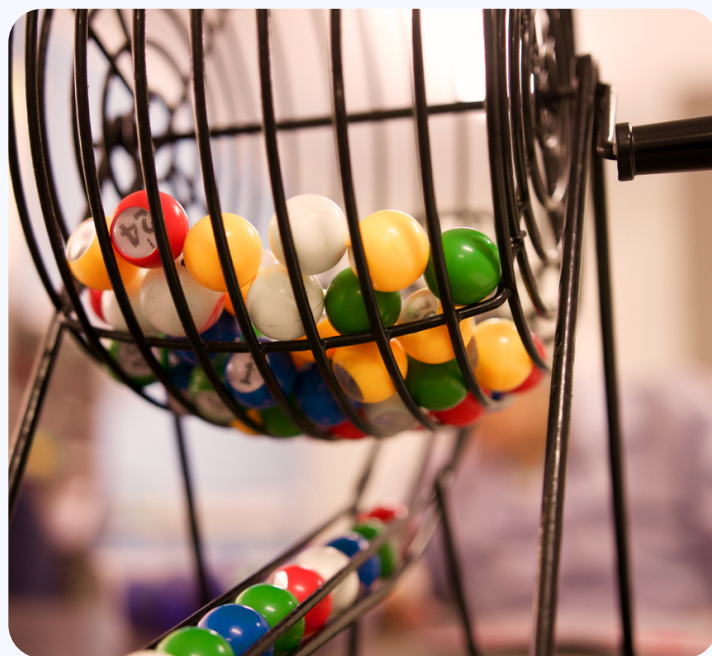
BINGO NIGHT- SUPPORT NEEDED
