WHAT ARE WE LEARNING?

Our topic for this half term is 'Amazing Me'. Children will be completing lots of activities related to the human body and the Five Senses.. Throughout the half term they will be investigating each of the five senses and sharing their ideas about these in order to write a five senses poem at the end of the half term. In Jigsaw work this term, the children will be focusing on the themes 'Being Me in My World' and 'Celebrating Differences'.

SNACK
